Fellowship Award:

** Up to 8 weeks full-time, paid research position in a Biochemistry Department laboratory.

** Compensation: Paid, \$460/wk, 8 weeks (exact dates and length are negotiable in collaboration with the Faculty mentor). *Students may not hold concurrent funding from another source unless specifically approved by Biochemistry DUS/DGS.*

Who can Apply?

* All interested students should apply - Students who have completed BCH301 and those who have taken or are currently enrolled in BCH302 or BCH 222 will be given preference.

* Students must find a mentor within the Biochemistry Department faculty (students with ongoing research projects in BCH labs *do* qualify).

Application Instructions:

- Submit an Application document including:
 - Your Major, overall GPA, relevant classwork and grades
 - A statement (1-2 paragraphs) of research goals
 - A statement (1-2 paragraphs) of how this experience will impact your future goals
- Identify the Biochemistry Dept primary faculty member that you have spoken to about doing summer research, or in whose lab you are currently.
